Just two quick items this update...

1) The Character Club has had 5 meetings after school at the Indian Land Elementary School near our home. We have had a great time with over 100 children on average for each Club session, from Kindergarten through 5th grade. The Kids' version of the Walk Thru the Bible Old Testament seminar caught on famously among the kids. Last Wednesday, we all "walked thru" the Old Testament with 77 hand signs they had learned over the 5 week period. They were able to execute them all in under 3 minutes! What fun for all! I wish I had their energy. After each Club meeting, I would come home and collapse! Pam was one of the teachers of the small-group workbook time, along with 14 other adult volunteers from our Sun City Carolina Lakes Bible Club. I have attached a few pictures for your enjoyment.

2) As mentioned above, Floyd flies to Cuba on Friday, November 4, to teach the book of Romans to some 25 pastors and pastors-in-training at the Las Palmas Seminary. The module (from Nov.6-12) will be intense, with class from 8am to 5pm every day, including breaks, of course. Some days we will even have evening sessions. We begin on Sunday night and go straight thru until Saturday noon. I love teaching Romans, and really look forward to going passage by passage thru the book with men and women who are truly motivated to learn. They come to the Las Palmas Campground where the Seminary holds its classes. Most will come after Sunday morning preaching and teaching, and will return the following Saturday afternoon to get ready for Sunday responsibilities. They will be busy!

So please pray for the students . . . and the professor . . . to have endurance! And especially pray that I would be super-clear in expressing God's truth in Spanish.
