We just returned from the capital city of Accra after attending a pastors' conference which included people from Ghana, Togo, Liberia, Kenya and India. There was rich singing. There was excellent preaching. There were challenging reports of what God is doing in Africa and India. What a blessing to be with these men and women who are serving the Lord in these countries.



Shirley and I completed teaching the Christian Home course with our five students. One day we had seven because a student brought his wife and little daughter. We had a good response from the class as they learned the Biblical principles for a Christian family. The challenges for the Ghanaian Christian family are many but to be Biblical and not traditional is the biggest challenge.



Our next class begins on October 10th when George teaches the Distinctives of Baptists. He will deal with the beginnings of the church and its history down through the ages. Then he will look at the importance of these distinctives in relation to the local church.

After teaching here in Ho we travel over to Togo to teach the course again to a group of students there. In that situation George will be needing a translator for the course. This will be a first for him in teaching a course.



We are learning about the culture here. Much reminds us of Bangladesh, only with an African flavor.
